Paper sacks generate 70% more air and 50 times more water pollutants than plastic bags.

...or Plastic?

Plastic bags do not decompose, but break down into smaller toxic bits that contaminate our soil and water.

Or, use cloth!

Each high-quality reusable bag has the potential to eliminate 1,000 plastic bags over a lifetime, and pay for itself with grocery store credits.

Disposable Diapers

Disposable diapers are the third largest consumer item in landfills. Compared to cloth diapers, throwaway diapers create 60 times more waste.

It takes 7 billion gallons of oil every year to produce disposable diapers. That's 2 billion more oil than the entire state of Wisconsin uses all year!
